Congratulations on being selected for the District IV Honor Bands!

Participation/Eligibility/Chaperones

All students who were selected are required to participate in 100% of the honor band weekend in order to perform in the concert. Any student who misses a rehearsal in whole or in part will be dismissed from the honor band at that time. A director or representative from each school must also be present for the entirety of every rehearsal/concert in which they have students participating. If the responsible party is not in attendance, all of the students from that school will be dismissed. Directors or chaperones are responsible for the monitoring of their students during the lunch and dinner breaks. **Meals are not provided by the district.**

Supplies: Students must be prepared with pencils, reeds, valve oil, etc.

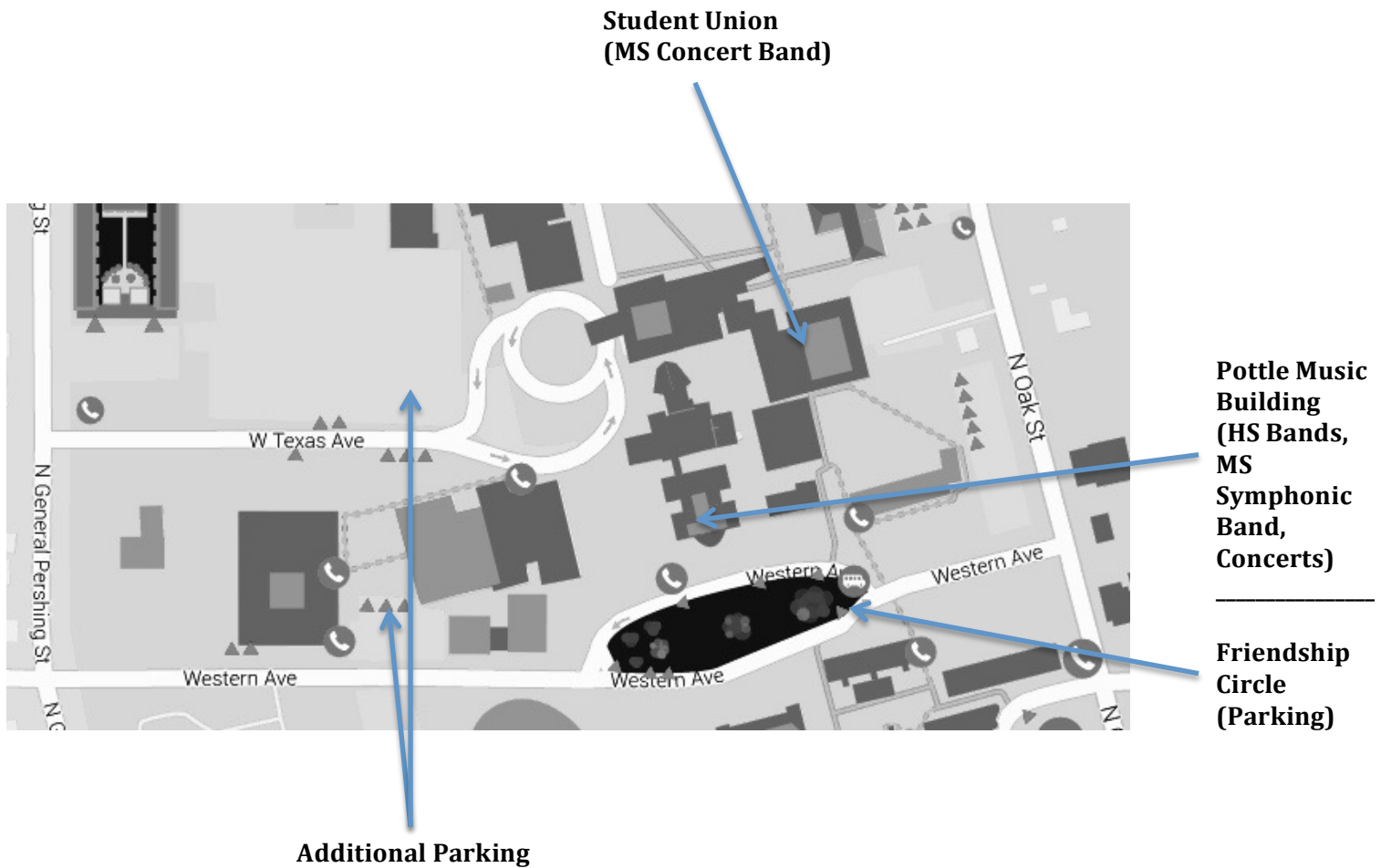
